

# HSE SUMMARY STATISTICS 2018

**144** people were killed at work



**550,000** non-fatal injuries to workers, of which **135,000** were over 7 day absences



31% slips, trips or falls  
21% lifting and carrying  
10% struck by an object  
8% falls from height  
7% acts of violence

**3.9m** working days lost due to non-fatal accidents at work

**£5.2billion** - annual cost of work-related injuries

**1.4m** workers suffering from work-related ill health

57% due to stress, depression or anxiety  
25% due to musculoskeletal disorders

**26.8m** working days lost due to work-related ill health

**£9.7billion** - annual cost of new cases of work-related ill health

**Agriculture, manufacturing and construction had statistically significantly higher injury rates**
